### TIE ONE ON

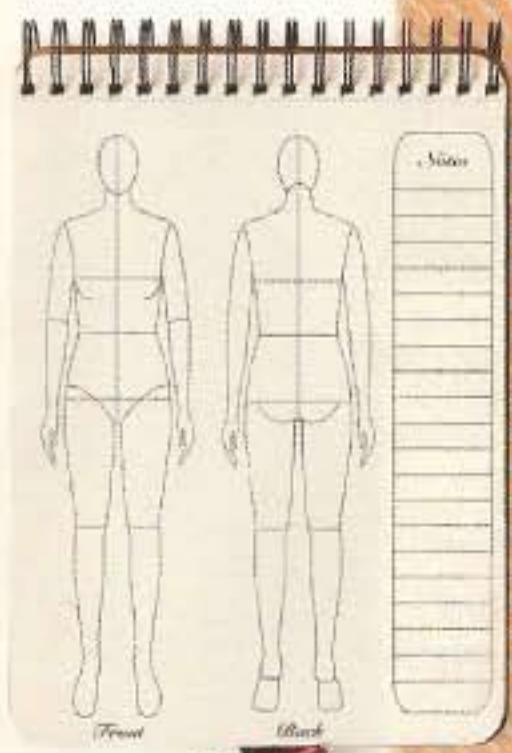
